## **Tips for Connecting with Students**

- **Meet your audience where they are**. Find out in advance about your audience's education level, experience with and interest in accounting.
- **Prepare your story.** Everyone's path is unique. Think about your journey to where you are today, and how you might relay that to students. PowerPoint templates are available for you to customize. Be sure to make your presentation personal and have fun with it!
- Stay focused on the big picture. Remember, these are students, not colleagues. Avoid too many details about your specific role.
- Illustrate your point with current events or stories. It's easier for students to connect with things that are relatable to what's happening in the world or relevant to them.
- **Help students find meaning in accounting.** Along with salary and title, students are looking for a meaningful career. So be sure to talk about the ways accounting has a positive impact.
- **Be authentic when telling your story.** Inspire students to consider a career in accounting by keeping your message truthful, but positive! *Learn more about telling your story here*.
- **Be creative when referring to your audience.** Students prefer not to be called 'kids'. Refer to them as students, 'Future Leaders' or even 'Future CPAs'.
